September 21st, the Alumni Association was informed that the demolition contractor has been working on mobilizing equipment to the site and anticipates a start date of late September for the physical structure demolition of the building. Over the next few weeks, you can expect to see equipment and site fencing arriving on site to prepare for the demolition process.



TAYLOR HISTORICAL SOCIETY



The City of Taylor, Historical Commission and Historical Society organized the renaming of the replica township hall on August 6, 2023, at Heritage Park. It has been renamed after Jared Sexton, Taylor Township's first supervisor. Jared's niece, Rose Farwell, gave a presentation in costume to those attending on Sexton history and where they came from before coming to Taylor. Plagues were placed above the doors of the town hall with Jared's name on them. The Jared Sexton township hall is also the Taylor Historical Society's gift shop. The Gift shop is open on the 3rd Saturday of each month. The Heritage Park West Mound Church that caught fire in 2020 was also rededicated on August 6. The work that has been done has made the church beautiful again and is back to being open for weddings through the Little White Chapel that rents the building.


