A Letter from the Superintendent

Dear Taylor Alumni Association,

My name is Ben Williams and I am honored
to serve as the new Superintendent of the
Taylor School District. I began my work here as
Superintendent on June 1, and was fortunate
to have a few weeks of transition time with

Superintendent Diane Allen, who retired after 44 years of dedicated service to the district. I am originally from Arlington, VA but I grew up all over Europe. As a young child, I was fortunate to have lived in Cyprus, Germany, Greece, and Turkey. My father was a career diplomat in the US Foreign Service, and this experience afforded me a unique perspective on different cultures and schooling systems.

I graduated from Wake Forest University in NC, and met my wife Kym (who is from Petoskey) while coaching gymnastics. I began my education career in 1996 in North Carolina, where I taught English and History. I then served as a HS assistant principal for two years, and then was HS principal for my last four years at a large class A high school in Hendersonville. In 2007, my family and I moved to Michigan to get closer to family. I was fortunate to land my first position as Principal at Saline High School just down the road in Saline. After five successful years, I moved north to accept my first Superintendent's position at Central Lake Public Schools. Five short years later, I am excited to be transitioning back to the area.

I have enjoyed getting to know a few of the active Taylor Alumni at the graduation ceremonies for the classes of 2016, and was pleased to see a strong level of support and engagement from the Alumni Association. I am looking forward to an active partnership and I thank you in advance for your help and support as I learn more about the Taylor School District.


