Sad News For Alumni

The school board has voted to consolidate the current two high schools into one. In school year 2017-18 all incoming 9th graders will be attending Harry S Truman High School. For the 2018-19 school year all 9th thru 12th grade students will be attending Harry S Truman High School. Committees are being formed to create a smooth transition; one of those committees will propose a new name for the consolidated high schools.

I am sure all Kennedy and Truman Alumni are very sad to hear about their school closing. JFK will have had 52 graduating classes

and HST will have had 44 graduating classes when the two are consolidated. All of us, staff and graduates have so many fond memories of the days spent in those schools, memories that will never be forgotten. However, with enrollment declining to less than 800 in each building, the consolidation was inevitable. Enrollment had dwindled to the point where it would be no longer possible to offer the classes needed for our current students.

The building now being occupied by Truman High School and other programs was designed to be able to house over 3000 students. The 1600 nine thru twelfth grade students can easily be housed in that building. Committees will be challenged to come up with the name of the new high school as well as school colors, mascot and more.

"New" is always exciting, but the closing of schools we loved is hard to deal with. We all have memories of all the great things that happened to us in the schools we loved. There will be many events in the next two years to honor all the years of John F Kennedy and Harry S Truman High Schools.
