The championship game between Chinese Taipei & USA Virginia was televised by ESPN and won by Taipei for the 2nd year in a row.

Over the years, teams have come from 30 different states in the U.S., 4 Canadian Provinces, Aruba, Blegium, Chinese Taipei, Curacao, Czech Republic, England, Germany, Guam, Guatemala, Indonesia, Italy, Mexico, Netherlands, Panama, Phillippines, Poland, Puerto Rico, Russia, Saipan, Saudi Arabia, US Virgin Islands, Ukraine and Venezuela.

Several players who have participated in the Junior World Series have also played in the majors. Gary Sheffield, former Detroit Tiger, Shannon Withem born in Ann Arbor and Delino Desheilds just to name a few.


This year the **low medalists** were Paul Chatzka, Chuck Hokey, Larry McKeown and Al Sebastian, all tied with a 40.
