Another Taylor Success Story



The Taylor Alumni Association extends congratulations to Mickey Turcheck for his outstanding career in the Taylor School District. Mickey graduated from Taylor Center High School (TCH) in 1960. While a student at TCH he had a great track career capped by his winning the State of Michigan pole

vaulting championship with a vault of 12 feet 9.5 inches.

Mickey went on to earn BA from Western Michigan University and a MA from Eastern Michigan University. He then returned to the Taylor School District as an Art instructor and Track Coach. Though he is retired now, Turcheck is still involved in the sport he loves.

Some highlights of his teams accomplishments:

- His teams had a win/loss record in meets of 124 wins versus 34 losses.
- His athletes won 82 conference individual championships and 67 individual regional championships.
- His teams finished in the top 10 in state meets eleven times.

Many of the athletes Mr. Turcheck coached went on to great careers. Here are a few:

- Debby Lansky (LaPlante) was ranked number one hurdler in the world in 1980.
- Shelby Johnson, was a state record holder in the 300 intermediate hurdles, a state champion and at that time, ran the fastest time in the entire United States.
- Earl Jones, when only 18, won a bronze medal in the 800 meters at the 1984 Summer Olympics in Los Angeles.

Obviously, Mickey Turcheck has been recognized for his outstanding career:

- He was inducted into the Taylor Sports Hall of Fame in 1998.
- Michigan High School Coaches Association Hall of Fame 2003
- Michigan Track & Field Coaches Hall of Fame in 2015

The Taylor Alumni Association is very proud of Mickey Turcheck and his accomplishments.
