This is a story with a happy ending, thanks to a fire medic who turned into a "dolphin" in an effort to save a teen-age boy.



Fire Medic James Zubor was honored with a proclamation from the City of Taylor on August 7 for his efforts during the water rescue of an autistic teenager in July.

The teen had wandered into a retention pond on the Wayne County Community College's Downriver campus.

His mother was on the shoreline and, concerned for his safety, called 9-1-1. Both the mother and the paramedics responding could not coax the teen out of the water, which had a depth of about 10 feet.

Fire Medic Zubor entered the water

and swam to the teen and again attempted to talk him into returning to the shore. By this time, the boy had been in the water for over two hours, so Zubor decided to turn into a superhero and offer the teen a piggyback ride.

He told the teen he could have a dolphin ride back to shore. All he had to do was get on his back. Flash forward: The teenager ended up back on the shoreline, thanks to Zubor the Dolphin, safe and sound and reunited with his mother.

By unanimous vote of the City Council, Fire Medic James Zubor was honored with a proclamation from the City of Taylor on Wednesday, August 7. We have no idea what he's going to do for an encore.
