Your Taylor Public Schools Foundation Scholarship Committee received scholarship applications from over 50 graduates and awarded over \$42,000 to 39 graduates.



Two students, Emma Jones and Gabriel Gondek, were awarded scholarships funded by Taylor Public School Alumni.

Emma graduated with a 3.75 grade point average while taking advanced placement classes. Her career goal is to be a Trauma or Surgical Nurse.
